DAY 0: transfer from Nice airport to Monaco.



DAY 1:44Nm, 2/3 hrs.

DAY 4:90Nm, 6/7h30 hrs.

DAY 5: 32Nm, 2/3 hrs.

From Portofino to Portovenere.

DAY 6: 88Nm, between 6 and 7 hours

From Portovenere to Isola Elba.

Part of the Tuscan archipelago, Elba is famous for his connection with Napoleon. The small inlets and the sandy beaches offer perfect shelter to relax and explore unspoilt nature. Enjoy the authentic flavours of the local cuisine made from recipes using the best from Tuscan, Ligurian and Campanian traditions.



DAY 7 - 39 Nm, between 2h30 and 3 hours

From Isola Elba to Isola Giglio.

Giglio is one of the hidden treasure of the Tyrrhenian Sea.

Campese is the ideal spot to enjoy the sea and the unspoilt nature, beachcombing and snorkeling recommended.

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Giglio Porto with its multicolour houses, is the only harbour of this lovely island used by the Etruscans for military purposes.



DAY 8 - 20Nm - 1h30

From Isola Giglio to Porto Ercole, Porto San Stefano. Excellent fish market and a profusion of restaurants. Porto Ercole is a place associated with pleasure (Night of the Pirates), good food, yachts and relaxation. The Terme di Saturnia Spa Resort offers an enormous variety of health and beauty treatments (50km from Porto Ercole).

DAY 9: Transfer to Rome airport, one hour approximatively. Prepare to disembark you yacht charter at midday.

Activities: snorkeling, diving, kayak, water ski and wakeboard, exploration with tender, massage (if available), beach picnic, shopping ashore...
